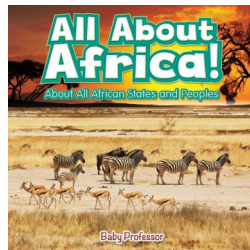
During Autumn Term Year 2 will be learning all about Africa with a history focus on Ancient Egypt. Each week please pick one task to complete from the activities below.

Can you describe three different African animals in riddles?

*E.g. I have black and white stripes, I look like a horse, I have a long tail.
What am I?*



Can you write a sense poem describing the African Savannah?

What can you see / smell/
feel/ hear?



Can you find out which countries are in Africa?

How many can you list?

Can you write 3 questions to ask someone that has been to Africa before? Do you know anyone that you could ask? If so ask them and record their answers with your questions

Can you paint or draw an animal you are interested in from Africa?

Pretend you have visited the Egyptian Pyramids. Can you write a postcard home to say what you have seen/done?
