



- Segment - chopping or breaking up the word.
- Blend - putting the word back together again.
- Grapheme - the letter name.
- Phoneme - the letter sound.
- Digraph - 2 graphemes/letters that make 1 phoneme/sound.

- Ask your child to draw their favourite toy on their whiteboard. Model a sentence to your child.

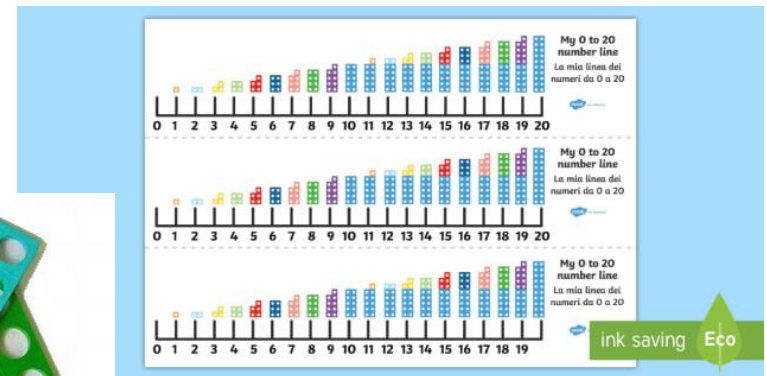
