Discuss the fact that the plotters still decided to go ahead with the plot. Guy Fawkes was found in the cellar by the King's guard with 36 barrels of gunpowder. He was captured and taken to the Tower of London. A few days later the rest of the plotters had either been captured or killed. - Children to complete the mini booklet templates either by drawing pictures and writing sentences to go with it or by sticking the sequencing cards in the correct order. <p>Optional: Debate with an adult – Guy Fawkes did what he did because he believed it would stop</p>
