Year 5 Greenwich Royal Observatory Visit – 16th January 2023

On **Monday 16th January 2023**, the children in Year 5 will be visiting the Royal Observatory and Planetarium in Greenwich to complement their Earth and Space learning in the Autumn term. The children will watch a planetarium show titled, “The Universe on our doorstep,” and will participate in a workshop led by astronomers with plenty of opportunities to ask questions and explore the site.

On the day - We will aim to leave school for no later than 9.00am and will be travelling by public transport (bus/train/DLR.) We will arrive back at school for approximately 4.00pm and will regularly communicate any updates to our arrival time.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch in a named plastic bag and a bottle of water (no sweets, fizzy drinks or glass bottles please.) If you would like the school to provide your child with a packed lunch, **please indicate this on parent pay**. There is no cost for children who qualify for FSM. Children will need to be dressed in full school uniform with a coat if the weather is wet and/or cold.

Costs- To cover the costs of the trip, we would be grateful for a voluntary contribution which works out at **£6.50** per child. We do not discriminate between those contributing and those who do not. All children will be able to participate **provided we have sufficient contributions** to make this financially viable.
