**If you can't access the lesson on the video,** you can still do the task; here it is:

Find things in your house and split them into:

- A) 2 equal groups (so three toys cars in one group and three toys cars in another).
- B) Now that you have two equal groups, can you move one item from one group to the other group so that you now have unequal groups?

**Then:**

- A) Make 3 equal groups (so three coins in one, group, 3 coins in a second group and 3 coins in a third group)
- B) Now, can you make them unequal by removing (taking away) a coin from one group? You could use grapes and eat them!
- C) What happens if you take away 1 coin from another group?

**Finally:**

- A) Find 12 items (ideally the same ,such as coloured pencils or pieces of pasta.
- B) Make 3 unequal groups using these 12 items
- C) Can you now make the 3 groups equal again?
- D) Now make 3 unequal groups using these 12 items again
- E) Can you now make 4 equal groups?
- F) Now make 3 unequal groups using these 12 items again
- G) Can you now make 5 equal groups?
- H) Now make 3 unequal groups using these 12 items again
