Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Emerald Class Swimming and Forest School

Every Tuesday **from the beginning of next term**, Year 4 Emerald Class will be returning to Midfield Primary School for swimming and Forest School activities. This will begin on **Tuesday 11th January 2022 and will run throughout the whole of the half term**. We will be leaving school at 8.45am, travelling by bus and returning in time for lunch. Our last session will be on **Tuesday 8th February 2022**.

Your child will need to come to school wearing their swimming costume (one piece for girls and trunks for boys) underneath clothes that are suitable for potentially messy activities, i.e. wellington boots or old trainers, tracksuit bottoms and a long sleeved top. They will need to have a separate bag for their underwear and a towel which they will take with them to Midfield. They will need to bring their uniform in their school bag to get changed into afterward. A swimming cap is a must whilst swimming.
