Each school within the Trust has a Local Advisory Council (LAC) who meet once per term on average. The primary focus of LACs is to support the school by:

- Sharing with the Headteacher and, as necessary, the CEO and Trustees the needs and views of their school community (including pupils, parents, staff and the local community).
- Supporting their school and other schools in the Trust through promotion of the Trust's values and priorities within the school and its community.

Although Local Advisory Councils do not have legal responsibilities, they are a crucial channel of communication between their headteacher and the wider school community.

The LACs are made up of representatives from the school community, including parents, staff, and the local community.

The Spring Partnership Trust strives to offer the very best education within our power to every child we can reach. Our member schools are part of a family that shares its knowledge, expertise and resources to change children's lives. This role will help to make a difference in the life chances for our children in an inclusive environment.
