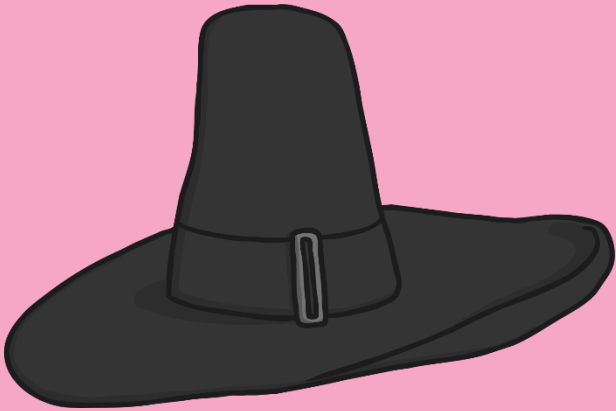


What could we be learning about?

Guy Fawkes was born on 13th April 1570, in York. His **Catholic** religion was very important to him but, at that time, **King James I** did not like people being Catholic in England.



He went to war in Europe to fight on behalf of Spain, which was a Catholic country. He called himself 'Guido' instead of Guy and became an officer.

When he came back to England, he became involved in a plot to kill King James I. A group of men, led by **Robert Catesby**, wanted Guy Fawkes to be involved partly because he understood how to use **gunpowder**, which is very explosive and dangerous.

This was their **Gunpowder Plot**.

How Long Ago?



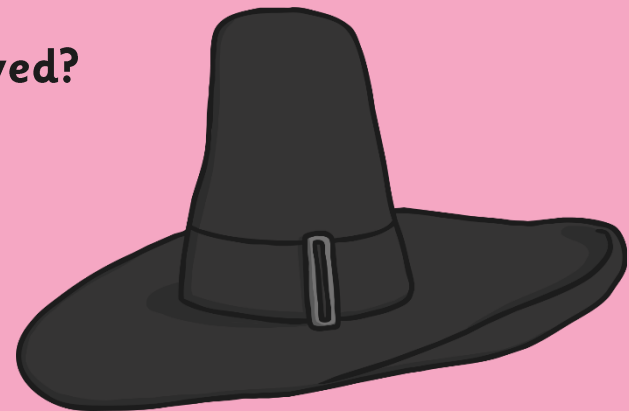
Guy Fawkes

- Were there telephones and computers?

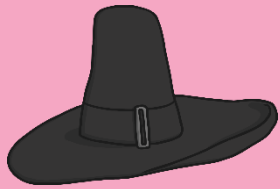

Can you explain what he would have used them for?



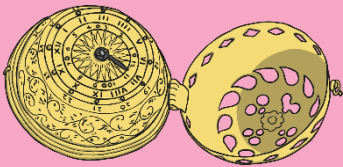
What Could Guy Fawkes Use?



Men always wore hats, usually indoors as well as outdoors.



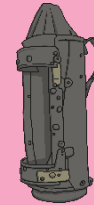
A quill and ink in case he needed to write a letter.



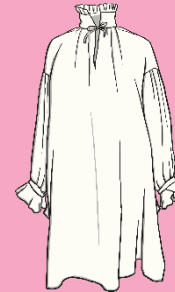
A pocket watch to keep the time.
